Cabanne House

Driveway into house is located off Lindell Blvd. There will be balloons on the sign leading in. Parking is along the driveway. Please pull off to side allowing cars to pass.

Cabanne House is actually the second house to bear that name. The house is second empire style and was completed in 1876. It was conceived as part of the original master plan for Forest Park. The exterior has survived with only minor alterations. The inside, after various uses, has been opened up to accommodate meetings and events. The second floor houses the offices of The St. Louis Ambassadors.
