

**ALUMNI SPECIAL STUDY WEEK IN BARCELONA
24 OCTOBER THROUGH 31 OCTOBER 2007**

24 October: "Opening Night Reception and Lecture at the hotel"

25 October: "A walk thru the Medieval town and some Modernisme"

Highlights include the striking, contemporary renovation of the Historic [1845] Santa Caterina Market by Miralles & Tagliebue [2004], the Picasso Museum and the gothic church of Santa Maria DelMar [1329-1384].

26 October: "Montjuic"

Montjuic is the hill that overlooks the South Eastern part of the city and is home to the National Museum where we will have a guided tour, visit the Mies van der Rohe Pavilion, the Olympic Ring and the Joan Miro Foundation by Sert.

27 October: "Poblet Monastery, an olive oil cooperative & a bodega"

Poblet Monastery [Cistercian 1180-1400], an olive oil cooperative [1913] by Montaner and Bodegas Raventos Blanc, 1989 architecture prize by Bach & Mora [1985-88]

28 October: "A walk thru the Eixample"

Here we have a large concentration of "Modernisme" landmarks including Casa Mila, "La Pedera" and Casa Batllo by Gaudi, Antonio Tapies Foundation and the Palau de la Musica, both by Montanaer.

29 October: "Girona"

A full day out of Barcelona to visit the medieval town of Girona and the work of "modernisme" architect Rafael Basso.

30 October: "More Modernisme"

Highlights include Gaudi's Sagrada Familia, Parc Guell and Finca Guell as well as the Hospital de Sant Pau by Montaner [1901-30]

31 October: "Colonia Guell & Igualada Cemetery"

This will be our final day of touring where we will see the Colonia Guell and Crypt and the Igualada Cemetery. We will end the day with our Final Group Dinner.

Included in the tour will be accommodations at the Hotel Condes de Barcelona, Passeig de Gracia [double occupancy]; coach as scheduled, tour guides and all entrance fees; lunch every day during scheduled tours, a final dinner and another dinner somewhere in the schedule as well as a concert. Also included is a Three Hundred Dollar [\$300] tax-exempt donation to the Summer School Scholarship Fund. **It is important to note that breakfast at the hotel is not included.**

Cost per person [based on double occupancy] is \$3,130. Single supplement is \$848. It will be your responsibility to arrange any additional nights at the hotel.
