Mr. Robert Furhoff and the Richard Nickel Committee is scheduling an at home event on Saturday, June 20, 2009 from 11:00 AM until 3:00 PM with lunch at 12 Noon. The event will be located at 3152 N. Cambridge Avenue, Chicago, Illinois. The apartment is a second floor walk up.

Features of the afternoon event will include the 3152 N. Cambridge Avenue building which is a 1890s, Richardson style, limestone, two story residence supporting a recently installed 21st Century steel stairs and porch, designed by a prominent Chicago architect.

Robert Furhoff will share his experiences in researching and restoring 19th Century interiors with a presentation of the resulting documentation. He will describe the research process and review examples of color reports and drawings. You will have the opportunity to view microscopic inspection of paint layers. A selection of original wallpapers, floor coverings and other decorative material will be on view. It will become apparent how his career has influenced his own residence as a comfortable mixture of 19th Century ideas with collections of furniture, picture frames, architectural fragments and the 1870s commercial photography of three women.

Mr. Ward Miller, Executive Director of the Richard Nickel Committee, also located at 3152 N. Cambridge, will present a selection of material and photographs relating to Mr. Nickel's documentation of buildings designed by architects, Dankmar Adler and Louis Sullivan and the on-going efforts to keep his work available to the public. This includes publication of Nickel's intended book with Aaron Siskind, titled "The Complete Architecture of Adler & Sullivan".

How To Get There:

3152 N. Cambridge Avenue is located just 1/2 block south of Belmont Avenue - three blocks west of Sheridan Road (CTA bus routes 151 & 156) – one block east of Broadway Avenue (CTA bus route 36). CTA Red Line to Belmont and CTA bus route 77 east to Broadway). Street parking is difficult. Just south of Belmont are two indoor garages, on the east side of Broadway and an open air lot on the west side. Lowest price is up to 3 hours for \$10.00 at the open air lot.
